To Whom It May Concern,

Re: AI104-KE (Superball No. 7) — Observed Activity, Corridor [REDACTED]

I am writing to document a series of incidents observed on non-consecutive nights between [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] involving AI104-KE, currently housed in containment.

On each of the nights in question, the item was observed bouncing persistently in the same spot outside the office of Director [REDACTED]. Surveillance footage confirms the item was in motion. How it exited its containment cell on these occasions has not been determined.

On one occasion, a sound monitor was placed in the corridor during the item's appearance. Two members of the acoustics team reviewed the recording. Their finding, submitted in writing, is that the sound captured does not match the item's previously logged acoustic signature. The recording is more consistent with splashing. No water source exists in the corridor. No water was present when staff arrived the following morning.

I am not in a position to offer an explanation. I am documenting this because it seems like the kind of thing that should be documented. I have cc'd [REDACTED] and left a message for [REDACTED]. Neither has replied.

The Director has been informed that routine maintenance is being conducted in the corridor.
