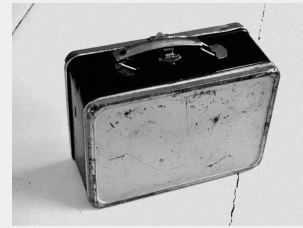


Metal Lunchbox (AI112-KE)

CONTAINMENT PROCEDURE:

DO NOT OPEN. The item has been removed from the lower lobby floor break room on [REDACTED] separate occasions. It has returned each time. Containment efforts are ongoing. Staff are reminded to label their personal items.



DESCRIPTION / ALTERED EFFECT:

Item is a metal lunchbox, blue and silver, showing significant wear consistent with years of use. No name is present on the item.

[REDACTED] of the [REDACTED] division lost the index finger of his [REDACTED] hand after reaching for the item. His incident report states he assumed it was his. The Bureau notes there was no basis for this assumption.

Some staff have suggested the item's presence in the break room prior to its acquisition was a deliberate placement by Human Resources intended to discourage food storage violations. HR has not confirmed or denied this. The Bureau notes that this explanation does not account for the finger.

BACKGROUND:

No record exists of the item being brought into the Bureau. HR conducted a review to determine whether the item belonged to any current or former staff member. It did not. It does not.

The Bureau has since issued a reminder to all staff regarding the importance of labeling personal food items and belongings. Compliance remains [REDACTED].
