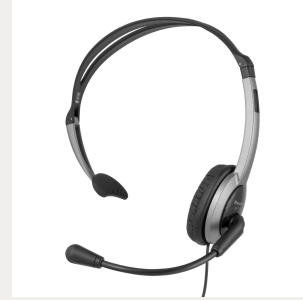


## **CallMaster Pro 200 (AI91-NR)**

### **CONTAINMENT PROCEDURE:**

Item is to be stored in a Black Rock panelled cell. A minimum distance of 100 feet from all landline and wireless phones must be maintained at all times. Under no circumstances should a voicemail be left for the item. Previous attempts to record a containment greeting resulted in [REDACTED] and the hospitalization of [REDACTED] staff members.



### **DESCRIPTION / ALTERED EFFECT:**

Item is a [REDACTED] brand cordless telephone handset, beige, manufactured circa 1991. No antenna or battery is present. The item has no known power source.

When a caller dials the item's associated number, the item rings once and routes to voicemail. The outgoing message is not the one the caller recorded. It is a message the caller has not yet left, to someone they have not yet decided to call.

Content varies. Tone varies. Bureau analysts have characterized the messages as uniformly "accurate," though this designation remains contested by [REDACTED] members of the review committee on the grounds that the future has not occurred yet and therefore accuracy cannot be verified. The committee's counter-position, that this objection will not have been relevant, is also on record.

### **BACKGROUND:**

The item was reported to the Bureau by a resident of [REDACTED], [REDACTED], following a series of complaints to their local telephone provider. The resident had been receiving calls from family members who denied placing them. When investigators arrived, the resident played back several of the stored voicemails. Two of the investigators recognized their own voices. One resigned the following week. The other [REDACTED].

The item was transported to the Bureau without incident. The resident was [REDACTED].
