These are reasonable questions.

I raised this with [REDACTED] in facilities. He said it was not his concern. I raised it with [REDACTED] in procurement. She said the same. I am raising it here because no other avenue has produced a result and I would like a result.

To be clear: I am not filing a complaint. I am filing an inquiry. The coffee is very good. I simply want to know whose it is.

If no one comes forward by [REDACTED], I will assume it is communal. I will act accordingly.
