Francisco MeCe (1988, Bogota, Colombia) is a visual artist, cinematographer and an emerging filmmaker based in Berlin, Germany. His work covers diverse fields of the audiovisual arts scene, developing pieces together with musicians, choreographers, filmmakers and both visual and sound artists. His collaborations have been featured at international festivals such as Rotterdam IFF, Toronto IFF, CPH:DOX, Guanajuato IFF, Moscow IFF or Vancouver IFF, among others. His first feature road film Wanderer shot in Iran was premiered in early 2020, while completing his studies in cinematography at the Deutsche Film und Fernsehakademie Berlin (DFFB) with the short film The Song of the Chrysalis.

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FILMMAKER'S STATEMENT

El Canto de la Crisálida (The Song of the Chrysalis) is the vehicle whereby I put an end to what I see as a hibernation cycle in Berlin, inspired by impressions and film ideas gathered during the last six years living in there. I wove the film with fragments and references to some other films and visual experiments collected during that period of time, also bringing together as characters some of the people that have left an important impression on my creative process.

The film occurs during that particular period of the year when the winter is coming to an end and the growing leaves on the trees start announcing the arrival of the spring. Coming from a tropical country, where the weather is more or less constant during the entire year and the routines aren't drastically affected by any seasonal change, my body and psyche have suffered in Berlin a process of constant transformation in that matter.

Being forced to surrender to the weather, I finally ended accepting the wintertime with its lack of daylight, the constant feeling of tiredness and quietness, as a period of deep concentration and the flourish of creativity. That 'wait for a natural restart' becomes the common ground of the portrayed characters: individuals practicing their routines on their own indoors, living in a kind of community, who barely interacts, aside from the neighbours sounds that filtrates the walls, the windows and the own mind.

The film was developed and shot much before the sanitary crisis of 2020. Even thought this type of landscapes can be associated with such type of confinement or isolation, the film wasn't conceived under the presumption or regard of a pandemic.

The film is dedicated to the memory of Luis Ospina.
