





GENERAL CONDITIONS & RESTRICTIONS

- All sales are final and no exchanges or refunds are possible.

Unless a specific date is stated, all services and gift certificates expire one year from the date of the Auction on March 3, 2020; unless otherwise specified, arrangements for dinners, vacations homes or other activities will be scheduled on a mutually agreed upon date with the donor(s). Please make reservations for specific sales as soon as possible to avoid disappointment or limited availability.
- Restaurant gift certificates do not generally include gratuity, tax or alcoholic beverages, and may not be exchanged for cash unless specified otherwise. Please tip generously and express your gratitude on behalf of Crystal Springs Uplands School. Reservations may be required and are advised.
- Any hotel reservations or air transportation are on a space-available basis and subject to holiday black-out periods. Remember, you are making your reservation based on a donor's terms and restrictions.
- Payments will be processed quickly following the event.
 American Express, VISA, MasterCard, Cash and Checks are accepted forms of payment.
- All minimum or opening bids must be respected and no item will be sold for less than its stated minimum or opening bid.
- An attempt has been made to catalog and describe all items correctly, but everything is sold "AS IS." The respective donors have furnished all statements of value appearing in this catalog. Items purchased by a successful bidder are not warranted and/or guaranteed by Crystal Springs Uplands School. SILENT AUCTION

- Each item in the Silent Auction has a Bid Sheet.
- To bid on an item, provide your bidder number next to the desired bid increment. Any bid will be disqualified if it fails to meet the minimum bid or minimum raise. The starting bid and minimum raise amounts stated on the Bid Sheet supersede what is specified in the catalog in the event of any differences. Some items may have a "Buy It Now" designation which allows bidders to automatically make a purchase at the stated price. "Buy It Now" allows bidders to ensure that they "win" an item and provide good value for the school.
- Bid carefully! Once a bid is placed, no erasure or crossing out is allowed. This is important since the person you overbid relies on that fact when shopping for other items. Please be considerate! Winning bids will be certified by an authorized Auction Committee Member. Your writing on a Bid Sheet constitutes a legal contract to buy.
- Silent Auction tables will close at 7:40pm, or as announced by the Auctioneer.
- In the event of a dispute, an Auction Chair may conduct a "mini" Live Auction between the parties and shall have sole and final discretion in determining the winning bid. Auction Chair reserves the right to move any item from the Silent Auction to the Live Auction for final sale.

- To enter a bid, raise your bidding number towards the Auctioneer (volunteer spotters will assist the Auctioneer in recognizing bidders throughout the room). The highest bidder acknowledged by the Auctioneer shall be the purchaser. The highest bidder shall be identified by his or her bid number.
- When an item has specified multiple users or recipients (i.e., Trustee Dinner), bidders are deemed to be bidding for a couple or one recipient only as expressly stated and acknowledged by the Auctioneer.
